- f. The Company conducts an introductory familiarization program / presentation, when a new Independent Director comes on the Board of the Company;
- g. Site visits or plant visits are organized for the Directors to enable them to understand and familiarize with the operations of the Company;
- h. Independent Directors are given all the documents sought by them for enabling a good understanding of the Company, its various operations and the industry segments of which it is a part. Further, when required, they meet without the presence of the Company's Management Personnel to discuss matters pertaining to the Company's affairs and put forth their combined views to the Chairman and Managing Director.

i. Monthly updates and Quarterly updates (either in the form of Monthly newsletters or Note) on relevant statutory changes in the Companies Act, SEBI Regulations and other statutory laws / regulations, applicable to the Company, are being sent to all the employees including the Board Members.
